2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows: On or about February 6, 2026, the defendant pointed a firearm into the Confidential Victim 1's vehicle while she was in the drive-thru. He stole a 9mm handgun, her purse containing bank cards, and Confidential Victim 1's and her daughter's cell phones.

On or about February 8, 2026, the defendant went into a store and pointed his firearm at Confidential Victim 2, who was working as a cashier, demanding and receiving money.

At both locations, he discharged his firearms.

On or about February 10, 2026, the defendant pointed a firearm at Confidential Victim 3 while she was in a drive-thru line. He demanded she raise her hands before he shot and killed her. He stole bank cards and her driver's license.

The defendant was captured on surveillance at all incidents. He wore a neon safety vest and hard hat. A search warrant was executed at his residence revealing stolen items from Confidential Victims 1 and 3 and the safety vest and helmet as well as suspected narcotics. A search incident to arrest revealed Confidential Victim 3's driver license.

It should be noted that the defendant is a convicted felon for Robbery in the First Degree (22951-01863A) for which he has absconded while being on Parole.
